## **Background & Rationale Information for Field Naming**

The information below outlines coach Dukes contributions to the education of Howell students over a 40 plus year career.

With the permission of Mr. John Young, HPS Athletic Director and Mr. Erin MacGregor, Howell Public Schools Superintendent, a committee was convened to discuss, research, and propose to the Howell Public Schools Board of Education to name the Howell High School Football Field "John Dukes Field."

The committee outlined Mr. Dukes' contributions to the education of Howell students. His 35 plus years of service in the classroom, and his impact in the Howell community, which includes 40 plus years of coaching and community service showcase his 'significant contribution' to HPS.

Mr. John Dukes is a lifelong Howell resident. He was born here and to this day still resides in the city of Howell. Mr. Dukes graduated from Howell High School and attended Alma College on an academic scholarship. He earned a double major from Alma College in Biology and Exercise Health and Science. Upon graduating from Alma he returned to Howell to serve as a teacher and coach for the entirety of his career.

Mr. Duke's dedication to Howell Public Schools is long standing. Growing up, he served as a ball boy for six years for the football program before entering high school where he excelled as a 3-sport athlete in baseball, basketball, and football. During his teaching tenure he served the district in both the physical education and science departments teaching various courses while instructing thousands of Howell students. In addition to the classroom, Mr. Dukes served as coach for the football, baseball, wrestling, and middle school basketball programs. Today, Mr. Dukes works at multiple sporting events for the district as a clock operator and periodically volunteers to coach in the football program.
